EARLY VOTING INFORMATION

Early Voting allows all registered voters to cast their ballot prior to Election Day between Thursday, February 23, 2017 and Monday, February 27, 2017 by voting at pre-designated sites named by the County Clerk. No excuse or reason is necessary to take advantage of Early Voting. Any vote cast during the Early Voting period is final and may not be revoked. Early Voters are not eligible to vote on Election Day. The last day to apply for a mailed ballot is Thursday, March 30, 2017. Any registered voter may apply for a ballot without specifying a reason. In Person voting will take place at the County Clerk's office before and after Early Voting period until Monday, April 3.
