Early Voting hours at Du Quoin City Hall from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. on Tuesday, March 13.

In Person Absentee Voting - Qualified voters must make application for an absentee ballot. No reason or excuse is necessary to vote by absentee ballot. Voters will vote on DRE (touch screen) machines. Votes will be processed and tabulated in the County Clerk's office after the polls close on Election Day.

Early Voting - Any voter may vote without excuse or reason. Voters must present a valid photo ID showing their voter registration address. Voters will vote on DRE (touch screen) machines. Votes will be processed

and tabulated in the County Clerk's office after the polls close on Election Day.		
Grace Period Registration & Voting - Any voter who failed to register or update voter registration information (such as change of name or address) may do so only in the County Clerk's office. After updating voter registration information, voters will vote immediately on DRE (touch screen) machines. Votes will be processed and tabulated in the County Clerk's office after the polls close on Election Day.		
Nursing Home In-Person Absentee Voting -- Will be conducted on-site at approved participating facilities on the morning of Friday, March 16, 2018. Voters will vote on optical scan ballots delivered to applicants by a team of election judges who will return the sealed ballots. Ballots will be processed and tabulated in the County Clerk's office after the polls close on Election Day.		
Mail-Out Absentee Voting - Mailed ballots will be sent to applicants who make application for an absentee ballot. No reason or excuse is necessary. Mail-out ballots will be sent to applicants on the same business day a proper application is received between Thursday, February 8 and Thursday, March 15. No ballots will be mailed after March 20. Voters will vote on optical scan ballots. Ballots received by 10 a.m. Election Day will be processed by teams of election judges in the County Clerk's office after the polls close on Election Day. Mailed ballots postmarked no later than March 20, 2018 but received by the County Clerk through April 3, 2018 will be processed and tabulated in the County Clerk's office on April 3, 2018.		
Provisional Voting - Voters who appear at their precinct polling place but are rejected because of a challenge because their name does not appear on the precinct rolls or certain other criteria may vote provisionally. Voters may vote their usual ballot, complete a special application and seal both inside a secure envelope. The sealed ballot is not counted on Election Day, but delivered to the County Clerk. Provisional voters have the opportunity to submit additional information to the County Clerk to verify registration status until Tuesday, April 3. The County Clerk will determine whether each ballot application is valid and shall be opened and counted or rejected. Ballots to be counted will be unsealed and tabulated on April 3, 2018.
